NARI's Member Recognition Program

Awards for Four Members per Chapter

NARI National will reward the Chapter member who has recruited the most new members from January 1 through December 31 each year. Reward to be a recognition plaque or other comparable compensation as determined by the committee.

NARI National will also reward three members of the Chapter who recruited the next three highest numbers of new members from January 1 through December 31 each year. Reward to be a certificate of recognition.

Each Chapter is responsible to provide National with the names of those to be recognized, and their recognition level, by January 15th in order to participate in the program. Submittal form will be provided by National and posted on the website.

NARI's Top Recruiter*

Based on the information submitted by the Chapters, National will determine the individual who was responsible for recruiting the most new members nationwide from January 1 through December 31 each year. That individual will be recognized and honored at the National Board of Director's meeting in the spring. Round trip airfare and hotel accommodations for one night will be provided by NARI. In the event of a tie for NARI's top recruiter, all of those involved in the tie will be recognized at the meeting, but travel accommodations will be provided for one individual chosen at random. This will be done impartially via "pull a name out of a hat" method. Reward to be a recognition plaque or other comparable compensation as determined by the committee.

NARI's Most Successful Chapter-2 awards

Chapters will also be recognized for their group efforts by NARI National. National will determine which chapter had the highest net percentage growth, and which chapter had the highest net member growth from January 1 through December 31, and will honor those chapters at the National Board of Director's meeting. Reward to be a recognition plaque or other comparable compensation as determined by the committee.

****The intent of the Top Recruiter AIM Award is to recognize and honor an individual member who had an active part in recruiting new members to their chapter. New members who are non-sponsored or who are recruited by paid staff should not be added to any individual's recruitment numbers in effort to achieve this award.***
